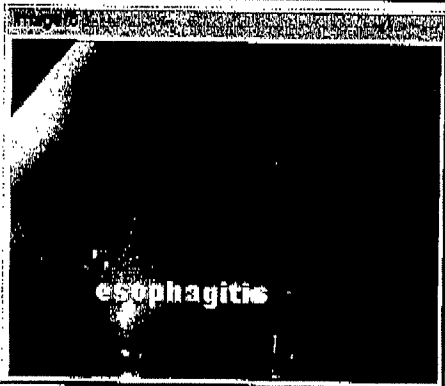
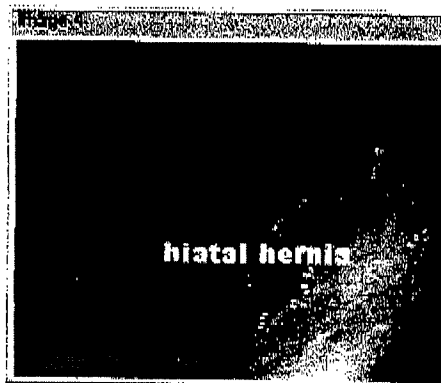
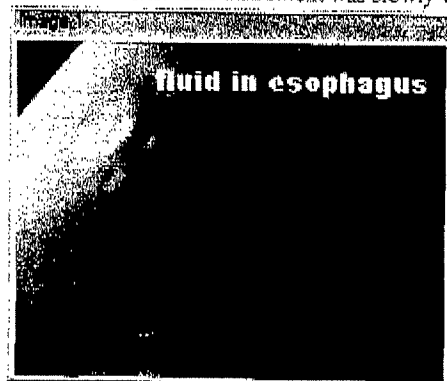

PROCEDURE: EGD with biopsy (43239)
INDICATIONS: nausea and vomiting, abdominal pain

MEDICATIONS: See Anesthesia Report.

DESCRIPTION OF PROCEDURE: After the risks benefits and alternatives of the procedure were thoroughly explained, informed consent was obtained. The Olympus GIF-H180 (1557) endoscope was introduced through the mouth and advanced to the second portion of the duodenum, without limitations. The instrument was slowly withdrawn as the mucosa was fully examined.



Esophagitis was found in the distal esophagus. It was Grade I. Multiple biopsies were obtained from the distal esophagus to evaluate for esophagitis. Retained gastric fluid was found in the fundus. Prior lap band effect was noted in the distal body. Slight narrowing and angulation was noted, however there was no obstruction. No convincing evidence of gastric sleeve procedure. Mild gastritis was found in the antrum. Multiple biopsies were obtained and sent to pathology. The duodenal bulb was normal in appearance, as was the postbulbar duodenum. Retroflexed views revealed a large hiatal hernia. The scope was then withdrawn from the patient and the procedure terminated.

COMPLICATIONS: None

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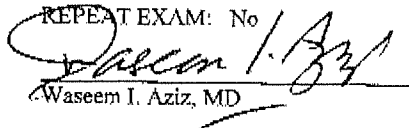
ENDOSCOPIC IMPRESSION:

- 1) Esophagitis in the distal esophagus
- 2) Retained gastric fluid in the fundus
- 3) Mild gastritis in the antrum
- 4) Narrowing and angulation in the body of the stomach
- 5) No convincing evidence of Gastric sleeve procedure.
- 5) Normal duodenum
- 6) A large hiatal hernia

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1) await biopsy results
- 2) anti-reflux regimen
- 3) continue PPI
- 4) Trial of reglan 10 mg po ac
