

[TRANSLATION]

The United States alert is very clear by recognizing it is not issued based upon clinical evidence but on hearsay from of supposed patients, and maintains its alert waiting for confirmation on Mexican authorities.

To this matter, the party I represent states, under oath of truth that Grand View Hospital, up to this day does not have and has not had nosocomial infections, nor the presence of the *pseudomonas aeruginosa* bacteria. There has only been one case where the patient returned because of the information he/she detected in social media regarding the aforementioned CDC alert, and the misuse of this alert made by parties with conflicting interest with our institution. To this effect, we attach evidence of the clinical follow-up of said patient as well as the results, obtained from the corresponding culture, which are negative for the above-mentioned bacteria.

The misuse made by third parties of the aforementioned alert, is unjust, wrongful and has caused serious damages to the party I represent.

Therefore, pursuant to article 8 of the Mexican Constitution, as well as articles 1, 3, 16 and 19 of the Ley Federal de Procedimiento Administrativo [*"Federal Law for Administrative Procedures"*] applicable by extension to the General Health Law, from you, C. Director, I respectfully:

REQUEST:

1. To acknowledge the capacity with which I appear before you regarding the party I represent, having already been acknowledged in other administrative documentation in the case file.
2. Inform, if evidence of the existence of nosocomial infection of any kind or of the presence of the *pseudomonas aeruginosa* bacteria has been found in the establishment GRAND VIEW HOSPITAL, within the proceedings for case file 18-SS-E-02-TJ-158-C-V.
3. If any impediment exists for the establishment GRAND VIEW HOSPITAL, owned by the party I represent, to fully exercise and provide hospital services, including services of bariatric surgery, derived from the case file or any other reason.
